All sizes of new or clean and ready-to-wear men's professional, business casual or work clothes, including shoes and accessories.

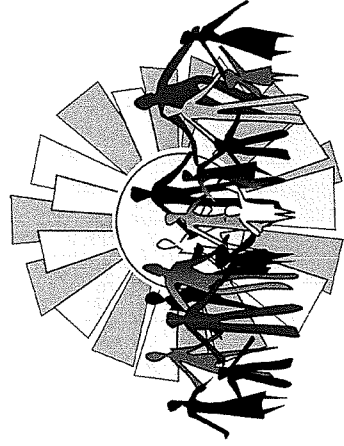

to opportunities for success.

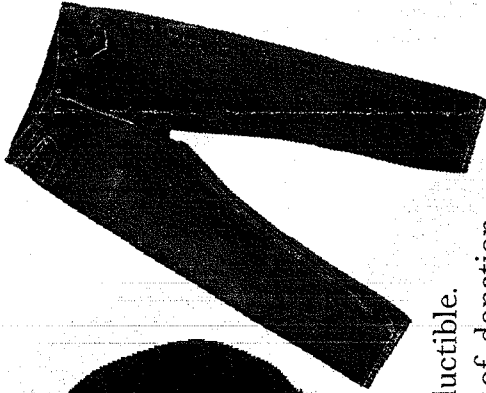
